As we approach Christmas and are fortunate to be able to share 'gifts' with one another, it is important to think of those who are less fortunate. Rev'd Sue Allen has a long association with the West Ankole Diocese in Uganda having agreed to go on a SOMA short term mission there, 15 years ago. The West Ankole Diocese is rebuilding and part of this is improving the clergy staff welfare, the state of their accommodation and salaries, currently the average Ugandan Clergy salary is A\$140.00 a month. This work will enable them to send their children to school and improve general health and welfare. One clear way to provide tangible, material support to subsidise the Ugandan Clergy income is via a monetary gift (\$50.00), to buy one goat for one family, providing the family with milk and the opportunity for meat or funds from the sale of offspring.

Your generous gift to assist the Ugandan Clergy is invited through NHWS. It is a tax deductible charity operated by the Diocese and is able to accept donations requiring this status. NHWS is also a fully audited entity and monies donated for assisting the Ugandan Clergy meet its purposes.
