- The consultations should be complete by Friday 30 June, unless alternative arrangements have been made.

- In addition to the group consultation, an online questionnaire will be loaded on the website <u>www.bendigoanglican.org.au</u> by close of business next Monday (5th June).
- Anyone should feel free to complete the online questionnaire individually. It will ask the same questions as those that are covered during the group consultation.
- This is provided for the following reasons;
 - For people who may have been unable to attend a group session.
 - $\circ\;$ For people who have divergent views to the consensus view of their group session.
 - \circ For people who feel they may not have been heard during the group session.
 - $\circ\;$ For people who have thought further about their views and have something else to add; or
 - \circ Anyone who wishes to contribute to the process for any reason.

Thank you for being involved in the planned consultations during June. The final output from this work will be a "Qualities and Requirements" document that will form part of the Diocesan Profile Pack for nominators and nominees. It will help inform the selection criteria for our new Bishop.
