## What to report to Kooyoora?

Reasonable concerns, suspicions and/or allegations of misconduct including:

- Harm to a child
- Child abuse and neglect
- Sexual assault, harassment or misconduct
- Criminal or suspected criminal behaviour
- Grooming
- Bullying or harassment
- Physical abuse
- Family Violence
- Elder Abuse
- Spiritual abuse
- Emotional abuse
- Financial misconduct
- Breach of Code of Conduct

### You can call Kooyoora if you:

- Need advice regarding reporting obligations
- Need advice about misconduct and safety concerns
- Something doesn't seem or feel right
- Want to run a scenario past us
- Want to make a complaint or know about the complaints process
- Want to apply for redress or know about the redress process
- Want information about clearance processes
- Want information on child safety

# Responding to disclosures:

- Ensure immediate **safety**
- **Listen:** avoid quizzing, stay calm and be patient
- Reassure: it's ok to have disclosed, address their concerns and that it is not their fault
- Respect: acknowledge how difficult it is to disclose, don't make promises you can't keep, keep within your role boundaries, explain what you need to do (report to Commission for Children and Young People [CCYP]) and that you will only share information for reporting obligations and safety.
- **Record** the information in a written note
- **Report** to Kooyoora as soon as possible
